We might see Harrogate filled with communities of followers of Jesus.

We have been seeking to do this with our whole lives.

As we continue to do this we want to build relationships.

At this time of increased isolation and loneliness we want to invest in connections, particularly into the next generation.

In 2022, 49.63% of adults (25.99 million people) in the UK reported feeling lonely 'occasionally, sometimes, often or always' and 7.1% (3.83 million) said they experience 'chronic loneliness' meaning they feel lonely 'often or always.' This has risen from 6% in 2020, indicating that there has not been a return to pre-pandemic levels of loneliness.'

Young people are among those most likely to experience loneliness. In a 2020 YouGov poll 69% of 13-19 yr olds said they felt alone "often" or "sometimes" in the last fortnight and 59% feel they have no one to talk to "often" or "sometimes". ²

We can do something about this

As we build connections between all generations we want to increase our investment in the next.

We want to continue our investment into our Children and Families work to see children and their parents gain a foundation of faith.

We are exploring how we can develop our team of youth volunteers, and whether we can match our financial investment into Children and Families to create a similar paid role for young people. An income increase of £15-20,000 would allow us create a Youth Leader role to go alongside our Children and Families Mission Leader.

We also want to invest into physical space for our growing youth and children's groups by re-developing the west end of the hall to create an extra "den" like space for young people. The costs for this are not yet known.

Prayer

Ask God to show us how He's calling us to invest in the next generation. Pray that He would call the right people to join our children and youth teams. Pray for our young people and those of the town.

Time

Is God calling you to give time to join a children's or youth team, train as a youth mentor or be part of the Toddler group team or Take Time?

The bulk of our income comes from regular giving from committed Kairos family members. Are you able to start giving to Kairos or increase what you currently give?



Where does Kairos' money get spent?

We use it to make sure the church runs well by investing into our work with Kairos Communities, Children & Families, Young People, and people of all ages!

Our biggest areas of expenditure are people – paying for our Operations Manager and Children and Families role, and making sure we give to the Leeds Diocese what it costs to have a full-time Pioneer Minister in place – this cost is currently £60,000 per year.
