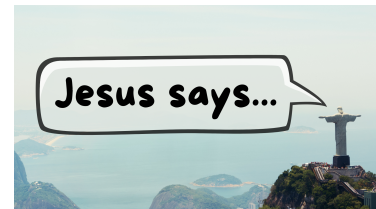


## Jesus Says – The Lord’s Prayer

### Questions

1. Why does Jesus tell his followers to address God as “our Father”?
2. Why would someone pray for God’s name to be recognized as holy?
3. When Jesus prays, "Your Kingdom come, and your will be done," what is he asking for?
4. What does praying “give us today our daily bread” remind us about in the Old Testament, and what might it instil within us?
5. Why does Jesus so closely connect God’s forgiveness of us to our forgiveness of others?
6. Jesus prays about temptation, or “testing,” and then prays about deliverance from the evil one. How do these concepts or ideas relate?

### Pausing to Pray

Join with others in Kairos pausing to say the Lord’s Prayer at midday (or a time close to that that works – like just before lunch.) Try saying the prayer out loud slowly, notice if any phrase draws your attention and pray a little about that.
